21. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. CAMS approved helmet and apparel, compliant with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, and fire extinguisher to NCR. Cars must be adequately muffled. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. A current and valid CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club must be presented at document check.

NAMS Competition Vehicles may be inspected to verify NAMS Vehicle Class Eligibility at any time during the event and reclassified as necessary upon direction of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course.

Production 4WD ATV vehicles must be fitted with a driver's side window net.

23. PRIZES & TROPHIES:

Will be determined by fastest times recorded by handheld stopwatches. Penalties shall be determined in accordance with the Khanacross Regulations

Khanacross Competition: 1ST, 2ND, 3RD Outright, 1st in each Class, 1st Junior & 1st Lady

24. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
25. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83.
26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to Parent/guardian.
28. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS Licence or superior (2NS is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the 2011 CAMS Manual.
29. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
30. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

31. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
32. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will take precedence
